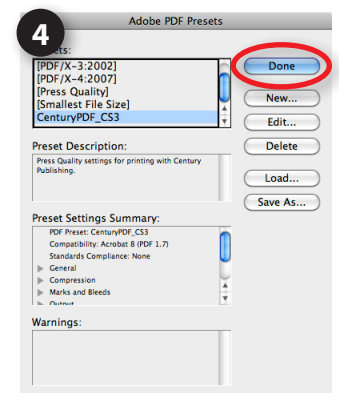
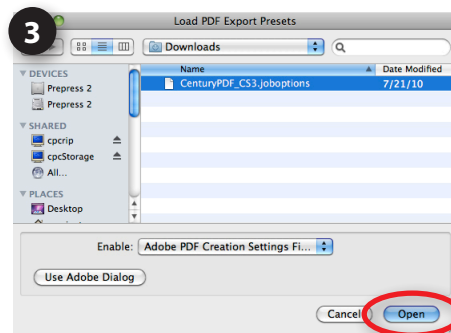
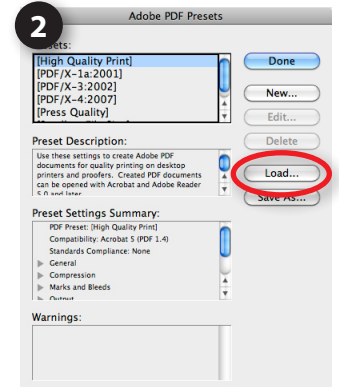
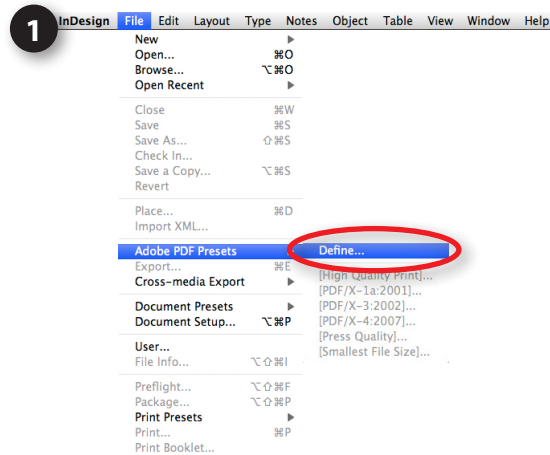


Overview

Loading an InDesign PDF Preset is quick and painless. Be sure you have downloaded the Century InDesign PDF Preset before you begin. You can download it from: <http://www.centurypublishing.com/customer-help-center/pdf-export-settings-guide/indesign/indesign-pdf-export-settings/>. Be sure to download the version that corresponds to the version of InDesign you are using and save the preset file to a location will be able to find later. For the purposes of these instructions we are using InDesign CS3, but steps are the same for other versions of InDesign.

Loading the PDF Preset

1. Within InDesign, click in the **File** menu, then click **Adobe PDF Presets** then finally click on **Define...**
2. This will open up a new window that lists currently loaded PDF Presets displayed in the upper left and buttons on the right side. Click on the **Load...** button.
3. Another window should now be open allowing you to browse to the PDF Preset file you downloaded. Navigate to where the file is saved, highlight it then click the **Open** button.
4. You will now be back in the window displaying the currently loaded PDF Presets and you should now see the CenturyPDF setting listed. Click the **Done** button to close the window and save the PDF Preset in your list.



Using the PDF Preset

When you are ready to make the final press quality PDFs of your magazine, you can use the Century PDF Preset in one of two ways:

Within InDesign, click on the **File** menu then click **Adobe PDF Presets** then click on the Century PDF preset you loaded. You will then be prompted for a location to save the PDF. After you have chosen a name and location for your PDF you will see the PDF export options, with the Century PDF settings already loaded.

or...

Within InDesign, click on the **File** Menu and choose **Export** (or type **Command+E** on Macintosh or **Control+E** on Windows). You will be prompted to choose a name and location for the file, as well as the format. Be sure you choose **Adobe PDF** for the format before you click **Save**. You will then see the Export Adobe PDF window. At the top of the window, be sure to chose the Century PDF preset before you click the **Export** button.
